C&C 30 CORINTHIAN TROPHY REQUIREMENTS

The Corinthian trophy will be a part of all C&C 30 One Design class racing starting on January 1, 2017. The rules are very simple – only allowed one professional (Group 3) sailor is allowed on board and only three new sails per calendar year may be used when competing for the Corinthian trophy. Corinthian trophy competitors will be racing with the rest of the fleet, and owners who register for the Corinthian trophy are also eligible for winning overall event prizes.

Owners may purchase a maximum of three new or used sails each year that will be eligible for Corinthian fleet racing. There is no age restriction on any of these three sails that are purchased used. Owners will still be able to purchase up to the maximum of six sails per year, so that they can sail events in either category. The three sails you select each year will be highlighted in the database, and each Sail Limitation Label shall be marked accordingly so administrators will be able to see which new sails are Corinthian trophy legal.

The rest of the inventory (as defined in Class Rules H.1.1 and H.1.2) that you declare for each event must be from the boat's existing Sail Limitation Labeled inventory, manufactured in the previous calendar year or older.

Each event host will be responsible for organizing the prizes or negotiating with yacht clubs to provide for the Corinthian trophies at Circuit events. Guidelines for awarding the trophy will be: If 1-3 Corinthian trophy entrants are registered, first place overall in that category will be awarded. First and second places will be awarded for events with 4-6 Corinthian entrants, and first through third will be awarded for 7 or more Corinthian entrants.

Owners who have sailed Class events as Corinthian entrants may opt at any event to sail as non-Corinthian entrants upon which they may sail under the normal restrictions on crew and sails defined in the Class Rules C.3.D, H.1.1 and H.1.2. Owners who have sailed Class events as non-Corinthian entrants may opt to sail any event as Corinthian entrants provided they abide by the restrictions set forth in this document.

The C&C 30 Class is excited to announce the creation of this new trophy. The owners requested the policy and anticipate getting more people involved in the fantastic racing and camaraderie that has developed in the C&C 30 Class by presenting a venue for those with differing time and budget frameworks to have incredible local racing at a fraction of the cost. We look forward to growing local and regional fleets over the next few years and invite anyone who has been looking at a C&C 30 to come join the fun.
